

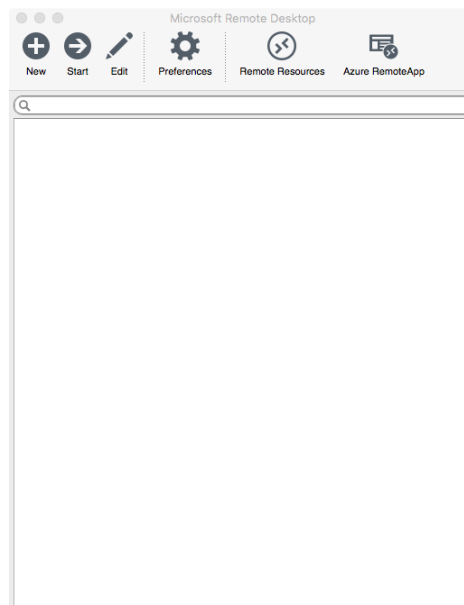
Getting Started with Remote Desktop Services on Mac OS X

Microsoft Remote Desktop Services gives you the ability to get work done from almost anywhere by providing access to your apps, files, and network resources.

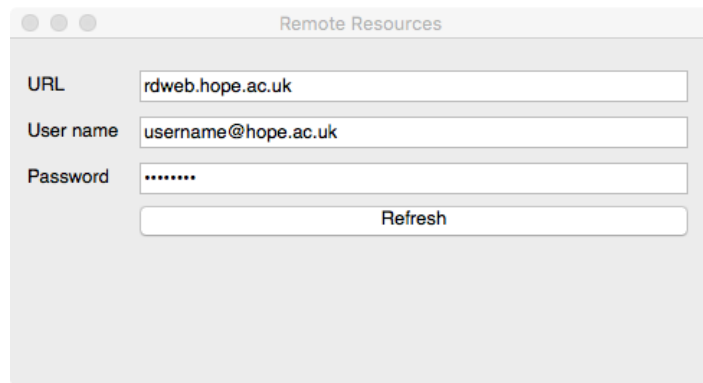
Here's how to get started with the Remote Desktop Services:

Follow these steps to get started with Remote Desktop Services on your device

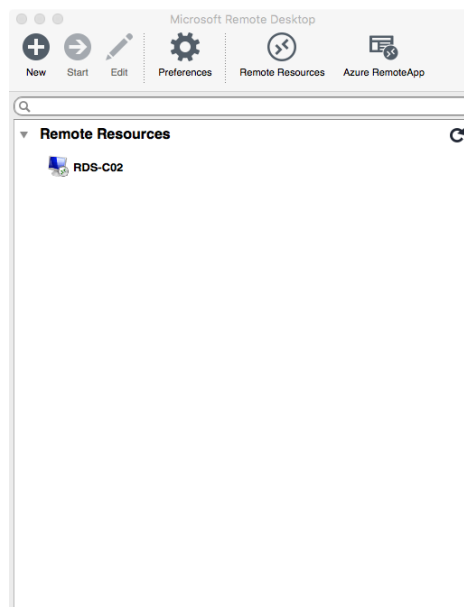
1. Download the Microsoft Remote Desktop Client from the [Mac App Store](#).
2. Launch the Microsoft Remote Desktop Client App.



3. On the Microsoft Remote Desktop connection center, click Remote Resources.
4. Enter information for the remote resource:
 - a. **Feed URL:** rdweb.hope.ac.uk
 - b. **User name:** Your Hope email address.
 - c. **Password:** Your Hope password.



5. Click Refresh and then close the Remote Resources window.
6. The remote resources available to you will be displayed in the connection center.



Start a Remote Desktop Connection.

1. Double click the remote desktop connection **RDS-C02** to start the remote desktop session.
2. If you are asked to verify the certificate for the remote PC, click continue.
