- 3. On the Microsoft Remote Desktop connection center, click Remote Resources.
- 4. Enter information for the remote resource:
  - a. Feed URL: rdweb.hope.ac.uk
  - b. User name: Your Hope email address.
  - c. **Password:** Your Hope password.
